TO: James Donnell, Constable of the Town of Richmond

Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Richmond, in said County and State, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Richmond Town Office in said Town, on Tuesday, November 2, 2021 from 8:00a.m. to 8:00 pm, then and there to act upon Article 1 and Article 2 as set out below:

Article 1: To elect a Moderator, by paper ballot, who will preside at said meeting. The “Maine Moderator’s Guide” shall be utilized by the Moderator.

Article 2: To vote by secret ballot on the following referendum question:

Do you favor filing a petition for withdrawal with the Board of Directors of Regional School Unit 2 and the Commissioner of Education, authorizing the Withdrawal Committee to expend \$25,000 and appropriating \$25,000 from unassigned fund balance for this purpose?
