The Town of Richmond (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Public Works Facility Sand and Salt Storage Building

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the Richmond Town Office located at 26 Gardiner Street, Richmond, Maine, until Tuesday, June 7, 2023 at 1:00 PM local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

The construction of a 60-foot by 120-foot sand and salt storage building with a capacity of up to 3,500 cubic yards of material at the Public Works Facility. The sand and salt storage building will include an 8-foot exposed cast-in-place concrete wall foundation, a new electrical service and power distribution panel, installation of a prefabricated fabric-style building on the cast-in-place concrete foundation, and associated site work, including grading, installation of stormwater best management practices, and paving.
